



## Take the Next Step

If you or your child are 9 years of age or older and struggle with facial acne, you may qualify for a new clinical research study. The study is for an investigational, topical medication (applied once daily) for moderate or severe acne.

### Initial Eligibility Criteria

- ✓ Age 9 or older (minors require parent or legal guardian approval)
- ✓ Have moderate or severe facial acne:
  - Between 30 - 100 inflamed acne lesions (small red bumps, pimples) on the face
  - Between 35 - 150 non-inflamed acne lesions (blackheads, whiteheads) on the face
- ✓ Are able to attend required study visits (up to 6 visits over about a 3-month period)

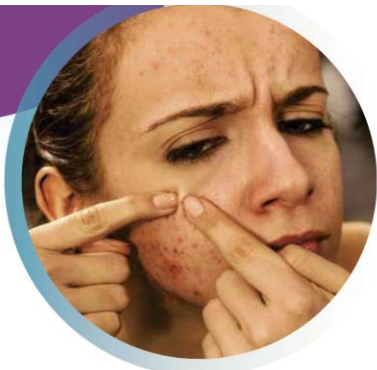


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## Are you or your child struggling with acne?

If you have acne, you're not alone. While nearly every teenager struggles with acne at some point, it's not uncommon to fight acne outbreaks well into our 20's, 30's, and 40's. Acne can consist of red bumps or pimples (these are considered "inflammatory lesions"), as well as whiteheads and blackheads (considered "non-inflammatory lesions"). And although there are many acne treatment options available, they do not work for all acne sufferers.



## You may be interested in a new clinical research study.

Right now, dermatologists at select centers in the U.S. and Canada are accepting participants for a new clinical research study. The study is for an investigational topical gel (applied once daily) for moderate or severe facial acne. If you and your child are 9 years of age or older and struggle with facial acne, you may qualify to participate.

If you qualify and choose to join the study, you or your child will be seen by a local dermatologist and will receive all study-related care at no cost. As a study participant, you will be asked to visit your local study center up to 6 times over about a 3-month period. These visits allow your study doctor to monitor you or your child's acne condition, and also discuss your overall experiences. You will also be compensated for your time and travel to attend these visits.



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
